



## ANTIPERSPIRANT EFFECT (TEWL)

Title	Assessment of the antiperspirant efficacy.
Objective	To assess the efficacy of a product on the excretion by the sweat glands after single application.
Schedule	Duration of the study: 1 day. Beginning: 2 weeks upon receipt of the samples. Report: 3 weeks after the end of the study.
Methodology	Measurement of the trans-epidermal water loss by means of the Tewameter® or VapoMeter®, or Evaporimeter®.
Procedure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Basal measurements of the TEWL on each armpit.</li><li>• Application of the product to one armpit at the investigating centre.</li><li>• 8 hours after application of the product: measurement of the TEWL on both test and control armpits.</li><li>• Statistical comparison of the results obtained on test and control sites before and after treatment.</li></ul> <p><i>Optional: Additional measurements</i></p>
